


CURRENTLY


Inconsistent implementation accross the site



SUGGESTED SITE STRUCTURE - AS PERCEIVED BY USERS THROUGH BREADCRUMBS




UPDATED: SUGGESTED SITE STRUCTURE - AS PERCEIVED BY USERS THROUGH BREADCRUMBS



OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS


Remove the breadcrumbs from the homepage.

The breadcrumbs for the homepage would be "Home". To respect the rule that the current page shouldn't be a link, "Home" shouldn't be a link on the homepage. Therefore it can be confusing for the user.



> Replace the colon by the right arrow.

It is more widely used across the web (65% vs 8% for the colon), therefore more easily recognized. Also, vertical separator such as colon can indicate an alternative. With breadcrumbs, we want to signify continuity and the right arrow fulfills this purpose better.



▶ If breadcrumbs are too long, include "..."

Breadcrumbs can be very long, especially with files, folders and subfolders. Ideally it should be kept on one line. The suggestion is to include ".." if total breadcrumbs characters(with spaces) is over 190 (which is about one line). Ideally, display all the breadcrumbs possible from the left hand side.
